# CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI) FEBRUARY 2023




# **Executive Summary**

The All-Groups CPI was 134.54 in the month of February 2023, compared with 133.99 in the month of January 2023.

The monthly change, February 2023 compared to January 2023, was an increase of 0.41 percent. The most significant monthly price increases were **Tobacco and Narcotics** (+28.71%). The increase was mainly the result of higher prices of **Narcotics**. Most of upwards contribution came from prices of **Miraa** (+50.00%). (Chart 2).

Over the twelve months to the month of February 2023 (inflation rate), the All-Groups CPI decreased to 5.43 percent, compared with 5.57 percent over the twelve months to the month of January 2023.

#### **Consumer Price Index (CPI) February2023**

General Inflation rate: All Groups CPI, February2023

The rate of inflation for February 2023 is the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the twelve-month period, from February 2022 to February 2023.

The **All-Groups CPI** decreased to 5.43 percent over the twelve months to February2023 compared to 5.57 percent over the twelve months to January 2023.


The All-Groups CPI monthly change for February 2023 was an increase of 0.41 percent.

**General Inflation rate: Selected Groups, February 2023** 

The rate of inflation for **Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages** and **Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas** are the most significant items in the consumer basket in terms of expenditure and have the largest weighted influence on the **All Groups CPI**.

**Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages** experienced a monthly increase of 0.00 percent during the month of February 2023 compared with a decrease of -1.42 percent in January 2023. This was due to an increase in the prices of some foodstuffs. As a result, the year-on-year inflation decreased to 5.41 percent in February 2023. This is compared to the year-on-year inflation of 6.72 percent experienced in January 2023.


**Housing, Water, Electricity, and Gas** experienced a monthly decrease of -0.02 percent during the month of February 2023. The year-on-year inflation made a decrease of 5.49 percent in February 2022. This is compared to the year-on-year inflation of 5.51 percent experienced in January 2023



## A. Major contributions of the different groups to the annual percentage change in the CPI





#### **Major contributions (positive):**

- **Tobacco & Narcotics** recorded an annual increase of 84.76 percent in February 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on Narcotics especially Miraa (+ 118.8%).
- Hotels & Restaurants recorded an annual increase of 8.97 percent in February 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on hotels (+14.67%).
- **Health** recorded an annual increase of 7.29 percent in February 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on outpatient services (+9.92%).
- **Housing rent, electricity** recorded an annual increase of 5.49 percent in February 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on electricity, gas and fuel (+14.87%).
- Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages increase of 5.41 percent over the 12-months to February 2023. The increase was mainly the result of higher prices of Food (+5.58%). Most of the upwards contribution came from prices of Wheat Flour (50.00%).
- **Miscellaneous** recorded an annual increase of 2.81 percent in February 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on personal care (+7.84%).
- **Clothing & Footwear** recorded an annual increase of 2.67 percent in February 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on operation of personal transport equipment (+8.71%).


• **Recreation & Culture** recorded an annual increase of 2.17 percent in February 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on Audio visual, Photographic and information processing (+2.74%).

### Major contributions (negative):

• There were no major negative contributions.

## Major contributions (positive):

• **Tobacco & Narcotics** recorded a monthly increase of 28.71 percent in February 2023. Most of the downward contribution came from prices of Narcotics (+50.00%).

• There were no major negative contributions during the month of February

The Consumer Price Index is generated by conducting a survey of purchaser prices for a representative basket of household consumption (goods and services), during the first and third weeks of the collection month. The prices are obtained from selected retail outlets in four data collection zones spread across Mogadishu.


