# CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI) AUGUST 2023



### **Executive Summary**

The All-Groups CPI was 142.58 in the month of August 2023, compared with 144.89 in the month of July 2023.

The monthly change, August 2023 compared to July 2023, was a decrease of -1.60 percent. There were no significant price changes in the month of August.


.Over the twelve months to the month of August 2023 (inflation rate), the All-Groups CPI decreased to 5.82 percent, compared with 5.98 percent over the twelve months to the month of July 2023.

### General Inflation rate: All Groups CPI, August2023

The rate of inflation for August 2023 is the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the twelve-month period, from August 2022 to August 2023.

The **All-Groups CPI** decreased to 5.82 percent over the twelve months to August 2023 compared to 5.98 percent over the twelve months to July 2023.

The **All-Groups CPI** monthly change for August 2023 was a decrease of -1.60 percent.


### General Inflation rate: Selected Groups, August 2023.

The rate of inflation for Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages and Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas are the most significant items in the consumer basket in terms of expenditure and have the largest weighted influence on the All Groups CPI.

**Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages** experienced a monthly decrease of -2.99 percent during the month of August 2023 compared with an increase of 0.37 percent in July 2023. This was due to decrease in the prices of some foodstuffs. As a result, the year-on-year inflation decreased to -2.08 percent in August 2023. This is compared to the year-on-year inflation of -1.19 percent experienced in July 2023.

**Housing, Water, Electricity, and Gas** experienced a monthly decrease of -0.20 percent during the month of August 2023. The year-on-year inflation decreased to 15.62 percent in August 2022. This is compared to the year-on-year inflation of 15.85 percent decrease experienced in July 2023



### A. Major contributions of the different groups to the annual percentage change in the CPI

### **Major contributions (positive):**

- **Tobacco & Narcotics** recorded an annual increase of 84.03 percent in August 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on Narcotics especially Miraa (+ 116.67%).
- **Communication** recorded an annual increase of 25.25 percent in August 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on telephone and telefax equipment (+40.17%).
- **Housing rent, electricity** recorded an annual increase of 15.62 percent in August 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on electricity, gas, and fuel (+20.68%). This was due to increase in prices of Solid Fuel (+44.00%).
- Clothing & Footwear recorded an annual increase of 14.36 percent in August 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on clothing (+16.55%) due to increase in prices of Garment for Men (+31.36%).
- **Health** recorded an annual increase of 10.56 percent in August 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on Medical Products (+19.81%).
- **Transport** recorded an annual increase of 9.70 percent in August 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on Transport Services (+32.36%). The increase was due to passenger transport by road (+49.21%).


- **Miscellaneous** recorded an annual increase of 7.74 percent in August 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on personal care (+8.91%).
- **Education** recorded an annual increase of 7.18 percent in August 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on secondary education (+28.26%).
- **Furnishing, Households and Maintenance** recorded an annual increase of 6.42 percent in August 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on Glassware, tableware and household utensils (+13.79%).
- **Hotels & Restaurants** recorded an annual increase of 3.60 percent in August 2023. Most of the upward contribution came from prices on hotels (+5.70%).

### **Major contributions (negative):**

• Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages recorded an annual decrease of -2.08 percent in August 2023. Most of the downward contribution came from prices on food (-2.14%) due to decrease in prices of Oil and Fat (-38.53%).

- Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages recorded a monthly decrease of -2.99 percent in August 2023. Most of the downward contribution came from prices on food (-2.89%) due to decrease in prices of Vegetables (-13.68%).
- **Hotels & Restaurants** recorded a monthly decrease of 3.10 percent in August 2023. Most of the downward contribution came from prices on hotels (-4.74%).

The prices are obtained from selected retail outlets in four data collection zones spread across Mogadishu.


